#### **Week 1: Teaching Summarizing**

<i>Day 1</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Vocabulary Lesson on the word Summarize (Use PP)</i></li> <li>• <i>Project the “Example Picture,” and do the “Example Warm-up” with students as a whole class.</i></li>   <li>• <i>If students are still putting down inferential information for their summary repeat for an additional week with your own pictures.</i></li> </ul>
<i>Day 2</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Warm-up #1</i></li> <li>• <i>Teacher-led Group Practice with Summarizing</i></li> </ul>

#### **Week 2: Teaching Questioning**

<i>Day 3</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Warm-up #2</i></li> <li>• <i>Teacher-led Group Practice with Summarizing and Questioning</i></li> </ul>
<i>Day 4</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Warm-up #3</i></li> <li>• <i>Teacher-led Group Practice with Summarizing and Questioning</i></li> </ul>

Day 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warm-up #3</li> <li>• Teacher Monitored Group Practice with Summarizing, Questioning, and Predicting.</li> </ul>

**Week 4: Teaching Clarifying**

Day 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vocabulary Lesson on Clarify includes review of previous strategies (Use PP)</li> <li>• Introduce sentence frames for class use, “Excuse me could you clarify _____.” “I need clarification on _____.” “I don’t quite understand what _____ means.”</li> <li>• Offer extra credit or reward for identifying what is not clear.</li> </ul>
Day 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warm-up #1</li> <li>• Teacher Monitored Group Practice with Summarizing, Questioning, Predicting, and Clarifying.</li> </ul>
Day 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warm-up #2 (Answer to Riddle Poem: a fish)</li> <li>• Teacher Monitored Group Practice with Summarizing, Questioning, Predicting, and Clarifying.</li> </ul>

Day 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warm-up #3</li> <li>• Teacher Monitored Group Practice with Summarizing, Questioning, Predicting, and Clarifying.</li> </ul>
Day 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warm-up #4 Answer to Riddle Poem: the wind</li> <li>• Teacher Monitored Group Practice with Summarizing, Questioning, Predicting, and Clarifying.</li> </ul>

**Week 5: Putting it all Together**

Day 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students are ready to practice all strategies together. Five days of warm-ups are provided in case that is what is needed.
